Some selections on this page are known to be invasive species. For instance, Nandina and Yellow Alder. They are left here and noted to highlight that some plants can be beautiful and invasive. Another example is Pampas Grass which is fine if well maintained. However, it produces seeds that spread far and wide into places where it is not welcome. Consider what can happen when you plant.

Attention Homeowners:

The following species of trees are considered “invasive” and homeowners are discouraged from planting these trees:

- Acacia (Acacia Species)
- Australian Pine (Casuarina Species)
- Brazilian Pepper (Schinus Terbinthifolius)
- Cajeput Tree or Punk Tree (Melaleuca Quinquenervia)
- Camphor (Cinnamomum Camphora)
- Chinaberry (Melia Azedarach)
- Chinese Tallow Tree (Triadica Sebifera)
- Ear Tree (Enterolobium Cyclocarpum)
- Eucalyptus (Eucalyptus Robusta)
- Flamegold Tree (Koelreuteria Elegans)
- Guava (Psidium Species)
- Jacaranda (Jacaranda Acutifolia)
- Java Plum (Syzygium Cumini)
- Mimosa (Albizia Julifrisin)
- Paper Mulberry (Broussonetia Papyrifera)
- Rosewood (Delbergia Sissoo)
- Tung Oil Tree (Aleurites Fordii)
- Umbrella Tree (Schefflera Actinophyllia)
- White Lead Tree (Leucaena Leucocephala)

No permit is necessary to remove these trees.

Some of the above-named trees are actually illegal to plant, transport or sell. Some trees have been prohibited by national, state, county and local regulations because of safety, health and environmental concerns.

PLEASE DO NOT PLANT FERNS

By their nature, ferns are invasive and require expensive hand removal.
