This form must be shared with Installer before installation takes place.

Owner will provide installation details and location of the TV Dish/ Antenna and cable components to the Building & Grounds Committee for review as part of this request.

Satellite TV dish / antennas and associated cable installation will not degrade exterior wall, fascia or wood, metal trim integrity or violate any applicable FCC safety regulations.

Installation of these items is prohibited on roofs, fascia boards and any other building trim material. **Installation is restricted to concrete and stucco wall surfaces.** The Association is responsible for the exterior maintenance of all buildings; homeowners who do not comply with the Installation Guidelines will be responsible for any damage to the roofs, fascia or exterior trim work.

Satellite TV dish and antennas can be installed in courtyard areas if not visible above the wall.

The owner of the satellite TV dish or antenna is responsible for the maintenance and/or replacement of the unit. The Association has no responsibility for the maintenance and/or replacement of the unit and accepts no liability for the same.

Any TV dish or antenna pole shall not exceed a height of 12 feet above the lower edge of the main roof per FCC guidelines. If required and necessary, the pole can be anchored to the exterior stucco wall, but cannot be anchored to any fascia boards or other exterior trim. All work must adhere to Seminole County Code.

Driveway Extension Guidelines

The work must be performed by a licensed, insured and experienced contractor, per Seminole County Code, if applicable.

The material for the driveway extension must be concrete. No pavers, bricks or stones are permitted.

The maximum width of 24" is permitted for a single car garage; a 36" maximum width is permitted for a double car garage, not to extend beyond the garage wall, on the walkway side of the drive.

Sod should only be removed the width of the extension.

If there are any trees in close proximity to the proposed extension the homeowner must hire (at their own cost) a licensed landscape company expert or arborist to verify the tree will not be damaged by the driveway extension. The arborist report including a copy of their invoice must be included with the work request form that is submitted to the Building & Grounds Committee for verification.

The homeowner will be responsible for labor and costs if any irrigation is damaged or needs to be relocated. This task will be performed by Association staff.

Any damage to the irrigation system will be the responsibility, at his or her cost, to repair.
